



President Carol's Message

Last week the members of the Rotary Club of Bayswater joined Rowville-Lysterfield to present \$5,000 to Stephen Barrington from Foothills Community Care. The funds were raised at the 2022 and 2021 Knox Art Show. Stephen Barrington was very appreciative of the donation for Foothills Community Care, as demand continues to rise each week.

Speaker – Essan Dileri (via zoom) - Rotary Peace Fellow

PP Jeff Power introduced Essan Dileri to members and then we got to enjoy a very good presentation. He spent a total of 11 years living with family in Pakistan and when they returned home there was nothing – the house was destroyed and their possessions gone. They returned to Pakistan and he did his final Secondary schooling before going to University and eventually completing a Masters degree.

Essan ended up back in Afghanistan and saw an opportunity to get the farming communities away from a dependence on growing opium poppies and saw that there was a market opportunity in growing Sunflowers to in turn enable them to harvest the saffron which was a major export and had the benefit of being legal. He proceeded to obtain development funds in 2009 which allowed him to fund 2 districts with \$60,000 each to enable the transition from opium crops to sunflowers for the extraction of saffron. This broke the connections with Drug and criminal gangs and ensured the survival of the local farming communities.

Following on from the project in Afghanistan he came to Australia pursuing a continuation of his project and even planned a 3 month return to Afghanistan however his family were being hounded by the drug lords etc so he and his family returned to Pakistan. Realising the danger for himself and his family Essan applied for refugee visas to Australia – a process that took more than 2 years to complete.

Essan is now in Australia and his children are at university or a couple of years off. Unfortunately, his marriage broke-up but he appreciates the networks of support available to him. He is now heavily involved in community work and is looking to get involved in international projects for the betterment of disadvantaged people.
