David began his presentation by explaining what Sailability does and many of us were excited to learn about the sailing program so close to home, in *Lysterfield!* Sailability makes sailing available to everyone. Lysterfield Sailability is held every Wednesday and every second Sunday between October and April. The facility is excellent providing great access for people with a disability of all ages.

Volunteers support Sailability to operate and provide an opportunity for clients from special schools to enjoy being able to sail. For those with physical disabilities, this experience is amazing. Clients and carers are encouraged to sail together. No prior experience in sailing is necessary, the sail boats are easy to sail the 1 person Monohull – maximum length 5m (16'4") or the 2 person Monohull – maximum length 5m (16'4").





A rescue boat is on the water to assist those who may need a hand. It is wonderful to see the client's faces enjoying the sail, along with the volunteers.

Sailability is funded by donations and although expenses are not high, donations are welcome.


