'FIT FOR PURPOSE' WORKSHOP REPORT

A recent weekend at a Club Transformation Workshop in Sydney, with Rotary delegates from 83 other clubs in Australia, proved very stimulating for our President and President Elect.

The motivation for such a weekend was to attempt to address the issue of the declining numbers of Rotarians in Australia. The aim was to gather an array of top quality speakers, to provide practical ideas and inspiration to the gathering. Then, with delegates armed with valuable information and inspired to make a change in their Club, Fit for Purpose coaches helped the delegates form a 'fitness' plan to move forward. This plan also responded to aspects of club operation that were reflected in the Member Engagement Health check that each member filled in.



Next Fundraising Theatre Night at 1812 Theatre on Wed 13th Nov.


At \$20 per head, this is a great fundraiser for the club and a cheap night's entertainment.
