

District Governor Ian Ballantine

The Rotary Club of Rowville Lysterfield warmly welcomed DG Ian Ballantine to our meeting. DG Ian spoke of the activities that are a key area of focus during his term. Firstly, the amalgamation of Districts 9810 and 9820 which becomes effective in 2024. Ian spoke of the excellent co-operation between the 2 Districts as we move forward to the new structures and encouraged us to network with clubs in 9820. Secondly Ian spoke of the implementation of regionalisation of zone 8 which will change the way we are organised. This will mean districts will eventually disappear and simplify the management of Rotary.



Ian went on to talk about the issue of member numbers which has forced the amalgamation of districts. Member numbers have declined 25% over the past 10 years reflecting the change to the age profile and the need to focus on attracting potential members.

Ian then spoke about District Conference which has a target of 350 for the Saturday night dinner due to the logistics of the venue. He went on to talk about how we need to engage members on Rotary projects such as Foundation, Polio Plus, RAM etc and keeping the focus on membership retention.

Finally, Ian spoke about the need to continue to focus on fellowship in Clubs as a major means of attracting new members and keeping our current membership base involved in activities.

It was lovely to see Mike Finke, our Assistant Governor who was able to join us for the meeting with DG Ian Ballantine


Regionalisation - Establishing Community Groups
