NOTES FROM LAST BOARD MEETING

A reminder that any member of the Club is welcome to attend the monthly Board meeting, although they cannot vote on motions. Matters arising: Donation of a raffle prize from Bunnings for the SHEBA event was received.

Finance: Bank balance \$91,646.15

A full statement of payments and income was made by the Treasurer.

Community Service: Stephen Barrington from Foothills Community Care has expressed his gratitude for the ongoing support with soup and muffins. We will be collecting items for the Foothills Reverse Advent Calendar hampers and doing a Club packing night, with extra items to be donated to Foothills to disperse as they see fit.

Friday 6th December is Foothills Women's Fair from 12.00 pm and we have been invited to attend to help.

Ian has continued to do gardening at Tamminya House.

Youth: Primary Schools Speech Competition Final is on November 20th at Manningham Hotel. District is offering \$500 for the start up costs of a new Interact Club.

International: Global Grant application is underway for Family Care Uganda. Alan has also applied to RC Balwyn for a grant for two more education scholarships. A RAWCS grant is underway for renovation of an outdoor area for Tamminya House.

Environment: Murray would like the Club to revisit the idea of an Environment Satellite Club-possibly with support of other Clubs in the Community Group. We need to stress there is an opportunity for grant money. Interact and/or Rotaract Clubs could be keen on Environmental projects.

Foundation: Neil to distribute further information to Club members following from the talk from Alma. We need to encourage members to be part of Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) e.g. donation of \$25-\$99 per year.

Fundraising: Both events discussed have been completed.

Art Show: Preparations continue and roster has been circulated.

Other Business: Patty Klep to be invited to Christmas Break-up and/or Changeover. A donation of \$500 to MSA Foundation will be made. Photo of Adrian to be requested for District Conference 'In Memoriam' session next year.

The DG Framework for Improvement designed by DG Colin Byron was circulated.

There is the possibility of reinvigorating the Interact Club at Scoresby SC and the possibility of establishing an EarlyAct Club at Karoo Ps.

Jeff is investigating the possibility with Knox Council and Bicycles Victoria of our club establishing a Bike Repair station in the Stamford Park Wetlands with Club recognition. It is possible it could become a bigger project for next Rotary year to include a BBQ shelter and seating.

Murray encouraged Club members to book for the DG Partner's Gala Ball on November 16th. He would also like the club to donate an auction item.


Andy has outlined how to go about it by using the QR Code, then leave your review on the Club's Google Business Profile page.






Congratulations to Daryl on the publication of his second book!


