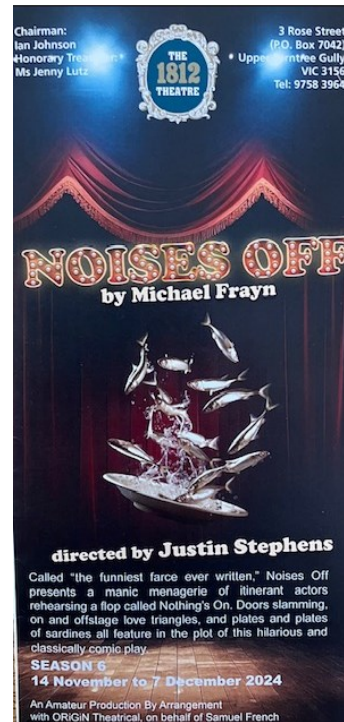

CLUB CHRISTMAS BREAK UP INVITATION



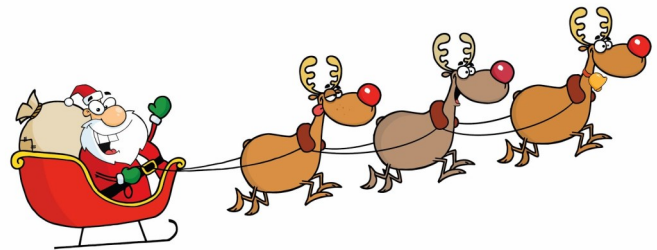
Please see to the left, an invitation to our Christmas get together, on **Tuesday December 10th**.
